Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether Universal Service Obligation Fund (USOF) has been provided under Telecom Policy-1999, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the provision of percentage of amount of Gross Revenue to be deposited by Telecom Operator Companies to this fund as per the Telecom Policy;
- (c) whether all the Telecom Operator Companies have deposited the amount of Gross Revenue in USOF as per the rules;
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the amount deposited as on date;
- (e) the details of the places in the country particularly in the backward class and the scheduled caste dominated areas where the Government has spent USOF for mobile network during the last five years, State-wise;
- (f) the details of the amount spent along with the details of the targets achieved, State-wise; and
- (g) the details of the amount to be paid for USOF as on date?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI DEVUSINH CHAUHAN)

(a) to (g) As envisaged in the New Telecom Policy 1999, Universal Service Obligation Fund (USOF) was established under Indian Telegraph (Amendment) Act, 2003.

At present, as per the License agreement the license fee 8% of the Adjusted Gross Revenue (AGR) is inclusive of USO Levy which is 5% of the AGR. Telecom Service Providers are depositing the Licence Fee as per license agreement. As on 31.03.2023, total of Rs. 1,40,150.32 Crore has been collected as Universal Access Levy under USOF.

USOF funded schemes inter alia provides mobile network in rural and remote areas which also includes Backward and Scheduled Castes dominated areas. The State/UT-wise details of funds disbursed/ spent during last five years (2018-19 to 2022-23) under various USOF Schemes for providing Mobile Network in rural and remote areas including Backward and Scheduled Castes dominated areas is given in **Annexure-I**. Physical achievements made under the said Schemes during last five years (2018-19 to 2022-23) is given in **Annexure-II**.

An amount of Rs. 69,126.84 Crore is available in the USO Fund at the end of March 2023.
