†3426. DR. SANJAY JAISWAL:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is contemplating to shut down the Central Organisation for Modernisation of Workshops (COFMOW) which has contributed significantly in modernisation of workshops in the rail network of India;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the issuance and opening of tenders by COFMOW has also been stopped; and
- (d) if so, the details of the other organisation for replacement of COFMOW for the purpose of tenders?

ANSWER

(a) to (d) COFMOW has been procuring Machinery & Plant for maintenance of rolling stock & other workshops. It has been observed that the machines are required to be procured & maintained in a decentralized manner. Therefore, the procurement of machines required for such maintenance has been decentralized. The need for a centralized organization is not felt anymore so COFMOW is being wound up in a gradual manner.
