344. SHRI N. REDDEPPA:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of districts identified under the Beti Bachao Beti Padhao Scheme in Andhra Pradesh;
- (b) the targets set and achieved under the scheme, State-wise;
- (c) the funds allocated and utilised under the scheme in the last three years, Statewise;
- (d) whether any study has been undertaken to review the functioning of the scheme; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

- (a) In the 15th Finance Commission period, Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP) is being implemented as Sambal Sub scheme of Mission Shakti in all the districts of the country including 26 districts from State of Andhra Pradesh.
- (b) Since Child Sex Ratio (CSR) is calculated on decadal basis by Registrar General of India through Census, Sex Ratio at Birth (SRB) has been set as a parameter for the progress of Scheme. State wise SRB details for the past three years is at **Annexure-I.**
- (c) The state wise details of fund released and utilized under the scheme in last three years is at **Annexure II.**
- (d) & (e) NITI Aayog evaluated the schemes of MWCD including BBBP Scheme. As per the evaluation report of NITI Aayog, the scheme has been able to generate significant mass-mobilization to eliminate gender discrimination and valuing the girl child and the scheme has been able to develop many good practices and community level initiatives. The awareness about the scheme was also found to be high.
