- (a) the quantified targets that had to be achieved under Gati Shakti Master National Plan classified, year-wise;
- (b) the current status of quantified targets to be achieved under the Gati Shakti Master National Plan classified, year-wise;
- (c) the State-wise number of project proposals under the plan since inception;
- (d) the details of the projects in Andhra Pradesh since receipt of project proposals;
- (e) the details of the amount sanctioned for each project in Andhra Pradesh along with names of private companies building the project, if any;
- (f) whether the Ministry has formulated any mechanism to track issues with respect to project development such as land acquisition; and
- (g) if so, the amount of time taken for acquiring land for each project being constructed in Andhra Pradesh?

- (a) & (b): PM Gati Shakti National Master Plan (NMP) was launched in October 2021 as a transformative approach for integrated infrastructure development for multi-modal, first and last mile connectivity to the economic nodes and social infrastructure. It is a tool that integrates economic and infrastructural planning with socioeconomic development. The National Master Plan platform along with the administrative setup under the initiative is facilitating integrated planning of multimodal infrastructure by the concerned Ministries using the available GIS data layers pertaining to the infrastructural assets. No quantified targets have been set under the initiative.
 - (c): Details of projects of the States, approved under the Part-II of the "Scheme for Special Assistance to the States for Capital Investment", are given at **Annexure-I.**

- (d) & (e): Rs. 202 Crore have been approved and disbursed for 2 Projects in Andhra Pradesh by Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance, Government of India through Part-II of the "Scheme for Special Assistance to States for Capital Investment" for PM Gati Shakti related expenditure. Details are given at Annexure-II.
- (f) & (g): The Project Monitoring Group (PMG) under PM Gati Shakti monitors the projects of more than Rs. 500 crore with specifically defined milestones on a portal. Under this mechanism, various issues pertaining to the projects including those related to land acquisition are monitored at appropriate levels for a time-bound resolution. The projects of less than Rs. 500 crore are monitored at State level. However, the information in respect of the said 2 projects is given at Annexure-II.
