#### PROMOTION OF MSME SECTOR

# 3524. SHRIMATI POONAM MAHAJAN: SHRI RAJESHBHAI CHUDASAMA

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the steps taken/being taken by Government for making a favourable environment to boost Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) sector under 'Ease of Doing Business' for the entrepreneurs especially in the fisheries business in Gujarat;
- (b) the number of registration done through Udyam Registration Portal from the State of Gujarat and Maharashtra, district-wise;
- (c) the details of promotional activities in the States to encourage the entrepreneurs for leveraging the schemes sponsored by the Government;
- (d) whether there are any roadblocks/constraints in implementing Government schemes in the States; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and steps taken/being taken by the State Governments in this regard?

#### **ANSWER**

# MINISTER OF STATE FOR MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SHRI BHANU PRATAP SINGH VERMA)

- (a): The Government has taken several steps to create a conducive environment for the promotion and development of MSMEs and under Ease of Doing Business. Some of these are given below:
  - (i) Udyam Registration (UR) Portal to provide fully online, paperless and transparent MSME registration process. No documents or proof are required to be uploaded for registering an MSME. Only Aadhaar Number and PAN is enough for registration. PAN and GST linked details on investment and turnover of enterprises are taken automatically from Government databases.
  - (ii) Digital Payments to pass on the benefits of the schemes of Ministry of MSME through digital payment gateway.
  - (iii) **MSME SAMBANDH Portal** helps in monitoring the implementation of Public Procurement Policy for micro and small enterprises.
  - (iv) MSME SAMADHAAN Portal- helps in empowering micro and small entrepreneurs across the country to register their cases relating to delayed payments.
  - (v) **MSME SAMPARK Portal-** A digital platform, wherein jobseekers (pass out trainees/ students of MSME Technology Centres) and recruiters get connected.

- (vi) Champions Portal for speedy redressal of grievances.
- (vii) Under Public Procurement Policy for MSEs order, 2012, the number of regulatory compliances in regard to Government to Business and Government to Citizen, has been reduced from 7 to 4.
- (viii) Government e-Marketplace (GeM)- facilitates online procurement of common use Goods & Services required by various Government Departments/Organizations/ CPSEs.
- (b): The district-wise data on the number of registration done through Udyam Registration Portal for the State of Gujarat and Maharashtra, district- wise is annexed.
- (c) to (e): (i) States/UTs have their specific policies/ initiatives to drive growth of MSMEs in their context. These interventions vary state to state in their approach, focus area and intensity. The Government of India supplements the efforts of the State Governments through various initiatives. The Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises implements various schemes for the growth and development of MSME sector in the country in areas of credit support, new enterprises development, formalization, technological assistance, infrastructure development, skill development and training and market assistance to MSMEs.
- (ii) The schemes/programmes inter alia include Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), Credit Guarantee Scheme for Micro and Small Enterprises (CGTMSE), Micro and Small Enterprises- Cluster Development Programme (MSE-CDP), Entrepreneurship Skill Development Programme (ESDP), Procurement and Marketing Support Scheme (PMS) and National SC/ST Hub (NSSH).
