IMPACT OF DEMONETISATION AND GST ON MSMES

3548. MS. S. JOTHIMANI:

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is a negative impact of Demonetisation and GST on the growth of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether it is true that several MSMEs were shut down during the last three years and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) the details and the number of MSMEs shut down during the last three years, State and yearwise;
- (e) the details of MSMEs shut down in Tamil Nadu, district-wise;
- (f) the impact of shutting down of MSMEs on the employment rate in the country, especially for the State of Tamil Nadu; and
- (g) whether the Government is taking any steps to ensure that MSMEs continue to grow, especially in the state of Tamil Nadu and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SHRI BHANU PRATAP SINGH VERMA)

(a) & (b): The Ministry of MSME has not conducted any independent assessment of the impact of demonetisation and GST on the growth of MSME Sector. In fact, the MSME sector has shown resilience in terms of GST growth despite the COVID-19 disruptions as can be seen from the table below:

(c): As per Udyam Registration Portal, the total number of MSMEs which were closed/shut down during 01.07.2020 to 31.03.2023 are as follows:

- (d): Details of MSMEs closed/shut down during the last three years, State and year-wise are at Annexure-I.
- (e): The details of MSMEs closed/shut down in Tamil Nadu, district-wise are at Annexure –II.
- (f): As per Udyam Registration Portal launched on 01.07.2020, the number of MSME which were closed/shut down during 01.07.2020 to 31.03.2023 was 19,687 and the number of persons employed in those MSMEs were 1,34,078. During the same period, 71,12,910 new MSMEs have been incorporated and registered on Udyam Registration Portal with an employment of 4,37,72,890.

In the same period, the number of MSME which were closed/ shut down during 01.07.2020 to 31.03.2023 in Tamil Nadu was 2,493 and the number of persons employed in those MSMEs was 12,132. During the same period, 7,23,522 new MSMEs have been incorporated and registered on Udyam Registration Portal with an employment of 43,19,187.

(g): The Ministry of MSME implements various schemes and programmes for the growth and development of MSME sector in the country on pan India basis, including State of Tamil Nadu. The schemes/programmes inter alia include Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), Credit Guarantee Scheme for Micro and Small Enterprises, Micro and Small Enterprises-Cluster Development Programme (MSE-CDP), MSME Champions, Entrepreneurship Skill Development Programme (ESDP), Procurement and Marketing Support Scheme (PMSS) and National SC/ST Hub (NSSH).
