Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that the number of CNG operated vehicles is increasing in the country, particularly in Jharkhand and the attraction of the people towards CNG is on rise and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether CNG operated vehicles are become more attractive among people in Jharkhand;
- (c) the number of CNG pumps opened in Jharkhand including Ranchi and other districts of Jharkhand;
- (d) the details and the number of such pumps that are likely to be opened in Ranchi in the coming years; and
- (e) the details of the work carried out by the Government in Ranchi under Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) during the last two years?

- (a) &(b) Yes Sir, total sales of CNG vehicles has rapidly increased over the past few years. As per Vahan dashboard maintained by Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, the total number of vehicles using CNG registered till 07.08.2023 were 60,39,224 across the country including 16,487 CNG vehicles in the state of Jharkhand.
- (c) & (d) Establishment of Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) stations is part of the development of City Gas Distribution (CGD) network and the same is carried out by the entities authorised by Petroleum and Natural Gas Regulatory Board (PNGRB). The authorised entities develop the CNG infrastructure in their respective Geographical Areas (GAs) as per their Minimum Work Plan (MWP) and techno-commercial feasibility. PNGRB has authorised 11 GAs (including 3 GAs spread over Bihar and Jharkhand) covering entire state of Jharkhand for development of CGD network. As per MWP, authorised entities have committed to establish 377 CNG stations in the state of Jharkhand over the next 8-10 years. As on 31.05.2023, the entities have been given the MWP target of establishing 16 CNG stations, however, the entities have established 81 CNG stations in the state of Jharkhand. GA-wise details of CNG stations in the state of Jharkhand is at **Annexure-**I
