ALLOCATION UNDER DAY-NULM

NO. 3563. SHRIMATI APARUPA PODDAR:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- a) whether it is a fact that Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana- National Urban Livelihood Mission (DAY-NULM) has been allocated a token amount of Rs. ten lakh in 2023-24 as compared to Rs. 794 crore in 2021-22;
- b) if so, the details thereof; and
- c) the steps taken by the Government to reduce poverty and vulnerability of the urban poor households by enabling them to access gainful self-employment and skilled wage employment opportunities?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI KAUSHAL KISHORE)

(a) to (c): A token amount of Rupees one lakh was allocated for Deendayal Antodaya Yojana- National Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM) in FY 2023-24, keeping view of funds available with the State/UT(s) in their Single Nodal Agency (SNA) Account for utilization under the Mission. However, based on the requirements from State/UT(s), additional funds have been arranged through Ministry of Finance, for release under the Mission.

Since, inception of the Mission, 14.51 lakh urban poor has been imparted skill training to enhance their employability, out of which 7.71 lakh have been placed under self and/or wage employment. In addition, loans with the provision of interest subvention have been disbursed to 8.34 lakh Self-Help Groups (SHGs) out of which 5.91 lakh SHGs have been assisted with Revolving Fund and 7.64 lakh loans have been disbursed under SHG Bank Linkage Programme for taking up activities for improving incomes.
