COLLAPSED FLYOVER

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether roads constructed by National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) are of substandard category as it is evident from 21 foot long flyover felldown on the Sohna Dausa stretch of the Delhi-Mumbai Expressway within three months after inauguration;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) the action taken by NHAI in this regard; and
- (d) whether any action is being taken/proposed to be taken by NHAI against the contractor and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

- (a)&(b) No incident of collapse of flyover on Sohna-Dausa stretch has occurred. However, spalling of concrete was observed in a localised spot at the bottom of deck slab at one underpass at Km 58.101. The same was rectified by the contractor.
- (c)&(d) National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) has issued show cause notice to the Contractor and Authority Engineer. NHAI has also engaged Central Road Research Institute (CRRI) for detailed investigation.
