Will the Minister of NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has carried out on assessment of the available land for setting up of solar power projects in various parts of the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to use barren land for the said purpose; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the names of the places identified for the said purpose across the country, State/UT-wise including Uttar Pradesh?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF NEW & RENEWABLE ENERGY AND POWER (SHRI R.K. SINGH)

(a) to (d) Solar projects are developed largely through private investments by the project developers selected through tariff-based competitive bidding, for captive consumption, and third-party sale, etc.

Land is under the purview of respective State Governments; and they are required to remove the hurdles in land acquisition

Further, the Solar Park scheme encourages use of waste/non-agricultural land for development of Solar Parks.
