Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION

be pleased to state:-

- (a) the details of the terminal/ traffic capacity of all the airports in the country in comparison to the annual demand at present, State and area-wise;
- (b) whether the Government has made any assessment of the expected increase in the number of air passengers by the year 2030 in the country and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the efforts being made by the Government to meet the said demand?

ANSWER

Minister of State in the Ministry of CIVIL AVIATION (GEN. (DR) V. K. SINGH (RETD))

- (a): The State-wise present traffic capacity of all the operational airports in the country along with the passengers handled during the FY 2022-23 is attached at Annexure.
- (b): As projected by the Airports Authority of India (AAI), the overall passenger traffic for the country is anticipated to reach approximately 780 million by the financial year 2030-31.;
- (c): To address the escalating demands of air traffic, AAI and other Airport Operators have targeted capital outlay of approximately Rs. 98,000 crore in the airport sector during 2019-2024 for construction of Greenfield Airports and new terminals, expansion and

modernisation of existing terminals and strengthening of runways, among other activities.

Besides, Regional Connectivity Scheme - Ude Desh ka Aam Nagrik (RCS-UDAN) also aims for revival and development of un-served and under-served airports/ heliports/ water aerodromes of State Government, AAI, Civil Enclaves, CPSUs for operations of the UDAN flights. An airport which is included in the awarded routes of UDAN and requires upgradation/development for commencement of UDAN operations, is developed under 'Revival of unserved and underserved airports' scheme.
