GOVERNMENT OF INDIA MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS LOK SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 3631 TO BE ANSWERED ON AUGUST 10, 2023 PROJECTS UNDER SCM

NO. 3631. SHRIMATI KESHARI DEVI PATEL: SHRI SANJAY JADHAV: SHRI ARVIND GANPAT SAWANT:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the current implementation status of projects taken up under the Smart Cities Mission (SCM) in the country during the last five years, State-wise;
- (b) the funds allocated for the projects under SCM during the last five years in the country with a particular reference of Uttar Pradesh and Maharashtra, city-wise;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to extend the Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) to new cities and towns;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (e) the number of cities rejuvenated since the launch of the said scheme;
- (f) whether the Government has also included towns under the said scheme and if so, the details thereof; and
- (g) whether there is provision of separate funds for this project to cover towns and small cities under the said scheme and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI KAUSHAL KISHORE)

(a) & (b) : Government of India launched the Smart Cities Mission (SCM) on 25 June 2015. 100 Smart Cities have been selected through 4 rounds of competition from January 2016 to June 2018. As per SCM Guidelines, Central Government will provide financial support to the extent of ₹ 48,000 crore over five years to the 100 Smart Cities i.e., on an average ₹ 100 crore per city per year. An equal amount on a matching basis will be contributed by the State Government/Urban Local Body (ULB). This ratio is 90:10 in the case of North East and Hilly States.

As on 7 July 2023, work orders have been issued by 100 Smart Cities in 7,978 projects of which 5,909 projects (74%) have been completed. State/Union Territory (UT)/Smart City-wise progress of projects is given in <u>Annexure-I</u>. ₹ 73,454 crore has been released for 100 Smart Cities; of which ₹ 66,023 crore (90%) has been utilized. State/UT-wise details of funds released/utilized (including Uttar Pradesh & Maharashtra) is given in Annexure-II.

(c) & (d) : Taking Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) forward & scaling the provision of basic amenities from 500 cities, AMRUT 2.0 has been launched in October 2021 to provide universal coverage of water supply in all the statutory towns/cities across the country (approximately 4,902 towns/cities) & universal coverage of sewerage/septage management in 500 AMRUT cities. Ongoing AMRUT Mission has been extended & will be funded with Central assistance up to 31 March 2024.

(e) : Under AMRUT, 500 cities have been selected in the country (now 485 cities after merger of 15 cities with other cities). The State/UT-wise number of cities selected under AMRUT is given in <u>Annexure –III</u>.

(f) : 4,902 towns/cities are covered under AMRUT 2.0 Mission. The State/UTwise number of cities selected under AMRUT 2.0 is given in <u>Annexure – IV</u>.

(g) : Under AMRUT, an equitable formula has been used to distribute the annual budgetary allocation in which equal (50:50) weightage is given to the urban population of each State/UT (Census 2011) and the number of statutory towns in the State/UT. The Central Assistance (CA) for the projects are provided in three instalments of 20:40:40 of the approved cost. The first instalment is released immediately after approval of the SAAP by the Apex Committee. Subsequent instalments are released after submission of utilization certificates along with other documents as per Mission Guidelines and certificate of IRMA regarding achievement of service level benchmarks.

Under AMRUT, The prioritization of ULBs for funding is done by States. Accordingly, States decide during formulation of the SAAP how the residual financing is shared between the State, ULBs and any other source identified by the State/ULB (e.g., Public Private Partnership (PPP), market borrowing). The State contribution cannot be less than 20 % of project cost. Similarly, under AMRUT 2.0, Central fund allocation to States/UTs for projects have been worked out by distributing entire central project funds among States/UTs giving weightage to urban population (Census 2011) and area of States/ UTs in ratio 90:10. The Central Assistance for the projects are provided in three instalments of 20:40:40 of the approved cost. The funding pattern of projects under AMRUT/AMRUT 2.0 is given in <u>Annexure-V</u>.
