RESIGNATION OF FACULTY MEMBERS AT NEIGRIHMS

3681. SHRI VINCENT H. PALA:

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be please to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware of the resignation tendered by faculty and other officials from NEIGRIHMS and if so, the details thereof along with the steps taken in this regard;
- (b) the number of faculty members who resigned from NEIGRIHMS during the last three years;
- (c) whether the Government is aware of the quality and efficacy of works done by the consultancy and contractors engaged and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the Government has put in place any mechanism for monitoring and inspection to check the quality and standard of work delivered by the engaged agencies and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the name of Agency/ Agencies entrusted to do the planning and execution of works along with the amount released for the purpose during each of the last ten years?

- (a) & (b) The number of faculty members resigned during the last 3 (three) years 2020-2022 is 18. Whenever any vacancy arises due to resignation, superannuation etc. the institute starts the recruitment process immediately.
- (c) to (e) Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India has constituted High Powered Committee (HPC) to review progress as well the quality of projects. High Powered Committee (HPC) has reviewed the progress of the following projects:-
 - 1. Setting up of Undergraduate Medical College with hostels.
 - 2. Regional Cancer Centre along with patient guest house.
 - 3. Expansion of Nursing College with Hostels.
 - 4. Setting up of Critical Care Hospital Block in NEIGRIHMS under PMABHIM Scheme.
