#### SHORTAGE OF PSYCHOLOGISTS/COUNSELLORS AT ONE STOP CENTRES

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of One-Stop Centres (OSC) opened, operational and closed down during the last three years, year, State and district-wise including Bihar, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Maharashtra, Haryana and West Bengal;
- (b) the number of women benefitted therefrom during the last three years, State and district-wise:
- (c) the quantum of funds allocated and utilized under OSC scheme during the last three years, year and district-wise for these above said States;
- (d) whether psychologists/counsellors are available at all these centres, if so, the details indicating the numbers thereof, State/UT and district-wise;
- (e) whether it is a fact that there is a shortage of psychologists/counsellors at these centres, if so, the district-wise details for the said States and the steps taken by the Government to cover this shortage; and
- (f) the other measures being taken by the Government to provide all facilities at OSC?

#### **ANSWER**

## MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

- (a) & (b):The Ministry of Women and Child Development has been implementing the One Stop Centre (OSC) scheme under Sambal component of Mission Shakti since 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2015. So far, a total of 801 OSCs have been approved in all 36 States/UTs. Out of these, 733 OSCs are currently functional across the country including Bihar, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Maharashtra, Haryana and West Bengal. 50 OSCs were made operational in last 3 years (FY 2020-21- 5, FY 2021-22 20 and FY 2022-23 25). The details of number of women benefitted through OSCs since inception is at **Annexure.**
- (c): Since the financial year 2022-23, the grants-in-aid are provided directly to the State Governments/UT Administrations. The quantum of funds released under OSC

scheme during last three years, for the States of Bihar, Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Maharashtra, Haryana and West Bengal is given below:

(d) to (f): The Ministry provides financial assistance to states / UTs for hiring of manpower for functioning of OSCs. However, the scheme does not envisage creation of regular posts. As such, the State/UT/District authorities are responsible for recruitment / hiring of suitable manpower / staff at these centres. There is a provision for hiring of 13 personnel for functioning of a One Stop Centre as per given details below: -

The Government has also engaged the services of National Institute of Mental Health and Neuro Sciences (NIMHANS) for providing basic and advanced training under the project named 'Stree Manoraksha' to the staff of One Stop Centres (OSCs) across the country on handling psycho-social and mental health care needs of women facing violence and in distress. NIMHANS have completed Basic Training and Certificate Courses in 27 states and 5 Union Territories, comprising 631 OSCs.
