#### **SCHEME FOR PROMOTION OF WATERWAYS**

3774. SHRI JUAL ORAM:

Will the Minister of PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS be pleased to state: पत्तन, पोत परिवहन और जलमार्ग मंत्री

- (a) whether the Government has implemented any scheme to promote waterways during the last five years;
- (b) if so, the amount spent/proposed to be spent by the Government for the said scheme:
- (c) the details of National Waterways proposed to be developed by the Government;
- (d) the details of steps being taken by the Government to augment the capacity of the waterways; and
- (e) the details of work started on National Waterways considering that 25 National Waterways have been identified by Inland Waterways Authority of India?

#### **ANSWER**

# MINISTER OF PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS (SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)

- (a) & (b)Yes Sir. The details of funds sanctioned for projects on National Waterway (NW) during last 5 years are detailed at **Annexure.-1**.
- (c)26 National Waterways have been taken up for development till 2030,the details of which is at **Annexure-2**.
- (d) & (e) For development of Inland Water Transport (IWT) in the country, 111 waterways (including 5 existing and 106 new) spread over 24 States have been declared National Waterways (NWs) under the National Waterways Act, 2016. On the basis of outcome of techno-economic feasibility study and Detailed Project Report (DPR) of these NWs action plan has been formulated for 26 NWs which were found viable for cargo and passenger movement. At present, development initiatives have been taken up in the 20 NWs. The details is at **Annexure 2**. To augment the capacity of Haldia-Varanasi stretch of Ganga River (NW-I), details of steps taken under Jal Marg Vikas Project (JMVP) are given at **Annexure 3**.
