- (a) whether recently a study has been commissioned by the National Commission for Women and NGOs on honour killings;
- (b) if so, the details and outcome thereof indicating the major findings of the study;
- (c) whether the study has revealed that 90 percent of the perpetrators of the crime were from the girl's family; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (d): As informed by the National Commission for Women (NCW), no study has been commissioned recently by the Commission and NGOs on honour killings.

However, a study was commissioned to Shakti Vahini (NGO) in 2009 on the subject titled "Honour Killings in Haryana, Punjab and Western Uttar Pradesh: NCW sponsored empirical study".
