CENTRALLY SPONSORED SCHEMES

379. DR. SUKANTA MAJUMDAR:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of Centrally Sponsored Schemes and Central Sector Schemes being implemented by the Ministry in the State of West Bengal during the last four years and the current year, year-wise, scheme-wise and district-wise including North and South Dinajpur districts;
- (b) the details of funds allocated, sanctioned, released and utilized for each of the above schemes during the last four years and the current year, year-wise, scheme-wise and district-wise;
- (c) the details of physical targets set and achieved while implementing the above schemes during the last five years and the current year, year-wise, scheme-wise and district-wise;
- (d) whether the Ministry has found any shortcomings while implementing the above schemes and if so, the details thereof including the steps taken by the Government to check those shortcomings;
- (e) whether there is time and cost overrun in any of the above schemes; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT

(a) & (b) For better implementation and efficient monitoring, all Centrally Sponsored Schemes of the Ministry being implemented in the country, including West Bengal, have been clubbed into three verticals, viz. (1) Saksham Anganwadi & Poshan 2.0 for improving nutrition indicators in the country (2) Mission Shakti, for safety, protection and empowerment of women; and (3) Mission Vatsalya, for protection and welfare of children. The details of these schemes are as under:

(i) Saksham Anganwadi & Poshan 2.0: This programme has been reorganized into 3 primary verticals: (i) Nutrition Support for POSHAN and for Adolescent Girls (ii) Early Childhood Care and Education [3-6 years] and (iii) Anganwadi Infrastructure including modern, upgraded Saksham Anganwadis.

(ii) Mission Shakti: Mission Shakti comprises of two sub-schemes '**Sambal**' and '**Samarthya**' for safety and security of women and empowerment of women respectively. The existing schemes of One Stop Centres (OSC), Women Helplines (181-WHL) and

Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP) have been made part of Sambal sub- scheme; while the existing schemes of Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana (PMMVY), Ujjwala, Swadhar Greh and Working Women Hostel and National Creche Scheme have been subsumed in 'Samarthya'.

(iii) Mission Vatsalya: Under Mission Vatsalya, the Child Protection Scheme(CPS) has been strengthened for better outreach and protection for children in need and care in a mission mode with the objective to: (i)Support and sustain Children in difficult circumstances. (ii) Develop context-based solutions for holistic development of children from varied backgrounds. (iii) Provide scope for green field projects for encouraging innovative solutions. (iv) Cement convergent action by gap funding, if required.

Only under 3 schemes of Mission Shakti, funds were being directly released to districts of all the States/UTs viz. One Stop Centre (OSC), Universalization of Women Helplines (WHL) and Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP) till FY 2022-23. However, BBBP & WHL are not being implemented by State Government of West Bengal. District-wise details of funds allocated/ released and utilized under the OSC scheme during the last four years is annexed at **Annexure-I**. In the rest of the schemes, the funds are being released to States/UTs. Details of funds allocated/ released and utilized under the schemes during the last four years and the current year is annexed at **Annexure-II**.

(c) The physical targets and achievements in West Bengal under schemes of the Ministry are annexed at **Annexure-III**.

(d), (e) & (f) PMMVY is being implemented in the State of West Bengal since 2017- 18. However, it had come to the notice that the Scheme was being implemented in the State with a different nomenclature i.e. 'Bangla Matri Prakalpa'. The State government later on agreed and ensured that in future the scheme would be implemented strictly as per the guidelines of PMMVY. On receipt of the written assurance from the State, the release of Central share of funds to the State Government of West Bengal has been resumed from March, 2022.

Under all the schemes of the Ministry, Utilisation Certificate/Statement of Expenditure are not being received from the State. Regular follow up meetings have been conducted with the State at all levels to report the utilisation of funds.

All the schemes of the Ministry were evaluated by NITI Aayog and their suggestions were incorporated while reorganising the schemes of the Ministry into 3 Missions.
