DOSES OF CORONA VACCINE

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has the data about the number of first, second and booster doses of Corona vaccine not administered to the people across the country; and
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (PROF. S.P. SINGH BAGHEL)

(a) & (b): The National Covid-19 Vaccination Programme covered population above 12 years of age with two primary doses of the vaccine while only 18 years of age and above population was given precaution dose. Against the estimates provided by Registrar General of India for 12 years and above population, a total of 102.58 crore (97%) 1st doses, 95.21 crore (90%) 2nd dose, and 22.88 crore precaution dose have been administered to eligible population.
