"USE OF COVISHIELD VACCINATION"

412. SHRI BENNY BEHANAN:

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government independently conducted a thorough safety study into the use of the Covishield vaccination after it was linked to an increased risk of cardiovascular diseases;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government to stop the reuse of syringes in hospitals to prevent the transmission of AIDS?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (PROF. SATYA PAL SINGH BAGHEL)

- (a) & (b) Three studies in this regard have been initiated by ICMR namely:
 - i. "Factors associated with sudden deaths among adults aged 18-45 years, India
 - ii. "Effect of COVID-19 vaccine on thrombotic events among 18-45-year-old population in India, 2022

iii. "Establishing the cause in sudden unexplained death in the young",

(c) Under the National AIDS and STD Control Programme (NACO), compliance of standard precautions with all blood specimens including not re-using of needles/syringes and ensuring their proper disposal to prevent transmission of HIV is mandatory. The Government has initiated procurement of auto disable (AD)/re-use prevention (RUP) syringes by the States/UTs to enable prevention of infection including AIDS.
