ROTATIONAL HEAD POLICY IN AIIMS

- (a) whether it is a fact that department heads in all the Central Government hospitals have been appointed on the rotation based policy;
- (b) if so, whether the Government proposes to implement the same policy in AIIMS, New Delhi and all other AIIMS in the country; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) The Government has issued guidelines vide Ministry of Health & Family Welfare OM No. A-45017/01/2018-CHS-V dated 10th January, 2023 regarding appointment and Model Standard Operating Procedure (SoP) for selection of Heads of Departments (HoD) in Central Government Hospitals from Doctors of Central Health Service (CHS) cadre.
- (b) and (c) AIIMS, New Delhi constituted a Committee to examine the proposal. The recommendations of the Committee were considered and it has been decided that collegium system may be implemented.
