#### ROTATIONAL HEAD POLICY IN AIIMS

### 435. SHRI DINESH CHANDRA YADAV: SHRI RAJIV RANJAN SINGH *ALIAS* LALAN SINGH:

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that department heads in all the Central Government hospitals have been appointed on the rotation based policy;
- (b) if so, whether the Government proposes to implement the same policy in AIIMS, New Delhi and all other AIIMS in the country; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

- (a) The Government has issued guidelines vide Ministry of Health & Family Welfare OM No. A-45017/01/2018-CHS-V dated 10<sup>th</sup> January, 2023 regarding appointment and Model Standard Operating Procedure (SoP) for selection of Heads of Departments (HoD) in Central Government Hospitals from Doctors of Central Health Service (CHS) cadre.
- (b) and (c) AIIMS, New Delhi constituted a Committee to examine the proposal. The recommendations of the Committee were considered and it has been decided that collegium system may be implemented.
