KENDRIYA VIDYALAYAS IN JHARKHAND

495. SHRI CHANDRA PRAKASH CHOUDHARY: SHRI SUNIL KUMAR SINGH:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) opened throughout the country especially in Jharkhand during the last three years;
- (b) the details of the KVs announced and running at present in Jharkhand, district-wise;
- (c) the time by which the construction work of above school buildings is likely to be started and also the time limit fixed by the Government to complete the above work;
- (d) whether any obstacle is being faced in the construction of such buildings, if so the details thereof;
- (e) the current status of the proposal of setting up of new KVs in Giridih Parliamentary Constituency;
- (f) whether there is any hurdle leading to inordinate delay in the tentative establishment of the said KVs and if so, the details thereof and if not the exact reason for such an undue delay;
- (g) whether the proposal to establish a new KV at Barwadih in Latehar district of Jharkhand is under consideration by the Government, if so the factual position in this regard; and
- (h) the reasons for delay along with the time by when the Government is likely to execute the process of establishment of KV in Barwadih?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (SMT. ANNPURNA DEVI)

- (a) As per information received from Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS), 19 Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) have been opened throughout the country during the last 3 years and current year (i.e. 2020-21, 2021-22, 2022-23 & 2023-24) out of which, 02 KVs viz. SER Dangoaposi (West Singhbhum) and Palamu (Palamu) have been opened in the State of Jharkhand.
- (b) At present, 41 KVs are functioning in the State of Jharkhand. Districts-wise details are annexed.

- (c) & (d) Construction of permanent buildings for KVs is a continuous process, which depends upon identification of suitable land, completion of lease formalities in favour of KVS by the sponsoring authorities, availability of funds and requisite approvals etc. The time required for completion of building is about 18 months from the date of start of the work in normal course of things. Out of 41 KVs in the State of Jharkhand, 11 KVs are functioning in temporary building provided by sponsoring agency. Out of these 11 KVs, 06 are at construction stage, 01 at Detailed Project Report (DPR) stage and construction work in respect of 04 KVs could not be started due to issues arisen after transfer of land / non-transfer of land by the sponsoring authority in favour of KVS.
- (e) to (h) Opening of new KVs is a continuous process. KVs are opened primarily to cater to the educational needs of the wards of transferable Central Government Employees including Defence & Para-military personnel, Central Autonomous Bodies, Central Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) and Central Institute of Higher Learning (IHL) by providing a common programme of education throughout the country. Proposals for opening of new KVs may be sponsored by Ministries or Departments of the Government of India / State Governments / Union Territories (UTs) Administrations, with commitment to provide requisite resources including land and temporary accommodation for setting up a new KV as per norms. The proposals are subject to approval of the competent authority.

As per information received from Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan, proposals for setting up of new KVs at Giridih Parliamentary Constituency and Barwadih in Latehar district have been received. The proposals received from the sponsoring authority for opening of new KVs are examined / processed at various levels and are subject to approval of the competent authority.
