**(a)&(b) Union Finance Minister in the Union Budget for 2022-23, announced the National Ropeways Development Programme – “Parvatmala Pariyojana”. At present, National Highways Logistics Management Limited (NHLML) has undertaken the work for development of 08 rope-way projects. The list of projects is attached as Annexure I.**

**(c) The ropeway projects under National Ropeways Development Programme have been planned to provide a sustainable and economical alternative mode of transportation to commuters in difficult hilly regions and congested urban areas. These projects are expected to contribute to tourism promotion and economy, and reduce the carbon footprint in these regions.**

**(d) MoRTH has allocated Rs. 200 Cr. for the development of Ropeways in BE 2023-24.**
