Setting up of IIT

Will the Minister of **EDUCATION** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to setup an Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) in each States and if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (b) whether the Government is likely to consider setting up of an IIT in the Parliamentary constituencies of Karnal and Kurukshetra on the lines of the model of Indian Institute of Management (IIM), Rohtak which was allocated to Haryana by the Union Government;
- (c) whether the Government is also likely to consider setting up of an IIT in Khandwa Parliamentary constituency at State level on the lines of the model of Indian Institute of Management (IIM), Indore which was allocated to Madhya Pradesh by the Union Government; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (DR. SUBHAS SARKAR)

(a) to (d): There are 23 IITs functioning in the Country, viz. IIT Bombay (Maharashtra), IIT Delhi (Delhi), IIT Kanpur (Uttar Pradesh), IIT Kharagpur (West Bengal), IIT Madras (Tamil Nadu), IIT Guwahati (Assam), IIT Roorkee (Uttarakhand), IIT(BHU), Varanasi (Uttar Pradesh), IIT Ropar (Punjab), IIT Patna (Bihar), IIT Hyderabad (Telangana), IIT Jodhpur (Rajasthan), IIT Gandhinagar (Gujarat), IIT Bhubaneswar (Odisha), IIT Indore (Madhya Pradesh), IIT Mandi (Himachal Pradesh), IIT Jammu (Jammu & Kashmir), IIT Bhilai (Chhattisgarh), IIT Goa (Goa), IIT Palakkad (Kerala), IIT Tirupati (Andhra Pradesh), IIT Dharwad (Karnataka) and IIT(ISM) Dhanbad (Jharkhand). As of now, there is no proposal to set up more IITs in the Country.
