Will the Minister of **CULTURE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has taken initiatives for re-imagining museums in India;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not the reasons therefor;
- (c) the number of museums which have been re-imagined so far and the details of the same, State/UT-wise; and
- (d) the details of the proposed museums to be re-imagined?

(a) & (b) : Yes Sir, Ministry of Culture operates two schemes namely Museum Grant Scheme (MGS) and Scheme for Promotion of Culture of Science (SPoCS), one of the components of which is development/modification of existing museums and modernization/upgradation/setting of new museums of existing Science Cities/Science Centres/Innovation Hubs respectively.

These schemes aim to provide financial assistance to modernize/upgrade and create a congenial spatial setting for diverse exhibitions, galleries and visitors amenities in the existing Museums and Science Cities/Science Centres/Innovation Hubs.

Further, Archaeological Survey of India by and large also develops the archaeological site museums with the antiquities recovered from archaeological excavations nearby the sites or from the detached portions/fragments of any centrally Protected Monument. These museums are upgraded and maintained every year through Annual Work Programmes as per requirement

Ministry of Culture is also establishing Virtual Experiential Museums at different locations across the country.

A 3 day international Museum Expo was held from 18<sup>th</sup>-20<sup>th</sup> May, 2023 at Pragati Maidan, New Delhi. Its main objective was to bring together all the stakeholders involved in museum field. Another objective was to have discussions about museums in India & abroad to create an atmosphere in museum industry to make them ready for futuristic museums

(c) & (d): A list giving the number of museums in States/UT etc. in respect of Museums Grant Scheme, Scheme for Promotion of Culture of Science (SPoCS), and Archaeological Survey of India are at **Annexure-I, Annexure-II** and **Annexure-III** respectively. In addition, at present, three virtual experiential museum have been set up in the country at Varansi, Ajanta caves and Vadnagar.

As and when the proposal for development/up gradation/setting of new museums etc. is received from State Govt./Autonomous Bodies/Public Sector Undertakings/Societies/Trusts/Academic Institutions. The proposal/DPR is examined as per guidelines of the MGS, and placed before the Expert Committee for its consideration/approval. Once the proposal is approved by the Committee, the financial assistance is sanctioned as per the guidelines.

Ministry of Culture is establishing Web based Virtual Experiential Museum on Liberation of Hyderabad Samsthan which will be posted on Salar Jung Museum's website and Central Universities in the State of Telangana.
