- (a) For training and skill development of Archaeological Survey of India (ASI) staff, Pandit Deendayal Upadhyay Institute of Archaeology (Pt.DUIA), conducts various short term training programmes, workshops and refresher courses related to conservation, preservation, management of heritage sites, field training of excavation and exploration.
- (b) The large work force of ASI across the country, coupled with limited resources, is a challenge, but utmost care is taken for organising capacity building programmes regularly.
- (c) ThePt.DUIA collaborates with various academic Institutions, organization and international bodies such as IIT's, Birbal Sahni Institute of Palaeosciences, Deccan Collage etc. and also invites National and International scholars as a resource personsimparting advance training to ASI personnel.
