Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) the total amount of GST collection across the country during the last three years;
- (b) the expenditure incurred by the Government during the last financial year;
- (c) the expenditure of the Government for the current year;
- (d) the funds allocated to the States by the Government during the current financial year by 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2023;
- (e) whether such funds are disbursed lumpsum without any fixed norm on the basis of contribution by the States during the last three years;
- (f) if so, the details thereof; and
- (g) if not, the reasons therefor?

(a): The details of Goods and Services Tax (GST) collected during the last three financial years are as under: -

<b>Financial Year</b>	<b>Gross GST (in Rs. Crore)</b>
2020-21	11,36,805
2021-22	14,83,291
2022-23	18,07,680

(b): The Total Expenditure estimated as per Revised Estimates of FY 2022-23 is ₹ 41,87,232 crore.

(c): The total expenditure estimated for the financial year i.e., Budget Estimates for FY 2023-24 is ₹ 45,03,097 crore.

(d) to (g): Rs. 2,36,560.01 crore has been devolved as part of Devolution of Net Proceeds of Shareable Union Taxes & Duties to States till 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2023. Devolution of shareable Taxes and Duties to the States is made as per the accepted recommendations of the Finance Commission.

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
