- (a) the details of the institutional structure and officials responsible for handling the Special Training Centres (STCs) under the National Child Labour Project (NCLP) Scheme for the rehabilitation of child labourers;
- (b)whether any STCs and District Project Societies have been established in the States of Uttar Pradesh, Rajasthan, Himachal Pradesh and Odisha particularly in the Deoria, Pratapgarh, Pali, Jhansi, Shimla, Balasore parliamentary constituency; and
- (c)if so, the details thereof and funds allocated for this purpose and the number of children it has benefited?

#### **ANSWER**

## MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI RAMESWAR TELI)

(a) to (c): Ministry of Labour & Employment has been implementing National Child Labour Project (NCLP) Scheme for rehabilitation of child labourers through District Project Societies under the chairmanship of the District Magistrate. Under the NCLP scheme, the children in the age group of 9-14 years are rescued / withdrawn from work and enrolled in the NCLP Special Training Centres (STCs), where they are provided with bridge education, vocational training, mid-day meal, stipend, health care, etc. before being mainstreamed into formal education system. NCLP scheme was approved for Contd..2/-

implementation up to 31.03.2021 and since then the scheme has been subsumed / merged with Samagara Shiksha Abhiyan (SSA) Scheme of Ministry of Education. Further, the NCLP Scheme was sanctioned in 324 districts and operational in 59 districts of the country as on 31.03.2021. No new STCs under NCLP Project have been approved after 31.03.2021. 58,289 number of beneficiaries were mainstreamed under NCLP Scheme during 2021-22.
