TRAFFIC RULE ENFORCEMENT BY DELHI POLICE

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether beat constables/officers of Delhi Police have been directed to forcefully confiscate vehicles of those scooty/motorcycles riders at checking posts or roadside who are without helmets at night and if so, the details thereof; and
- (b) the guidelines issued to the Delhi Police to adhere during checking of vehicles at the checking posts at night in absence of traffic police especially due to lack of documents of vehicles for any other reasons in this regard?
