Will the Minister of SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the present number of old age people living in old age homes in the country, State-wise;
- (b) the number of old age homes being operated in the country, State-wise including in Jharkhand, district-wise;
- (c) whether any funds have been released by the Government to operate these old age homes, if so, the total funds released during the last two years, State-wise including in Jharkhand, district-wise; and
- (d) whether the old age homes are operated through various organisations in Jharkhand, if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE FOR SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT (SUSHRI PRATIMA BHOUMIK)

(a) to (d): Department of Social Justice and Empowerment is implementing Integrated Programme For Senior Citizens (IPSrC), a component of Atal Vayo Abhyuday Yojana (AVYAY) under which grant in aid is provided to implementing agencies like NGO/Voluntary organizations for running and maintenance of senior citizens homes/old age homes. In these homes, facilities like shelter, nutrition, medicare and entertainment are provided free of cost to indigent senior citizens.

At present, there are 18080 indigent senior citizens living in 601 senior citizens homes (old age homes) assisted under IPSrC. Statewise details of old age homes under IPSrC and beneficiaries therein are at Annexure-I. Details of Senior Citizens Citizen Homes in Jharkhand and Organisations running these homes, district wise are at Annexure-II. Details of grant in aid released to NGOs during last 2 years under IPSrC, Statewise and including Jharkhand are at Annexure-III. Details of funds released to NGOs in Jharkhand, district wise, are at Annexure-IV.
