SPMRM IN BIHAR

752. DR. ALOK KUMAR SUMAN:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of funds allocated and spent by the State of Bihar under Shyama Prasad Mukherjee Rurban Mission (SPMRM) during each of the last three years;**
- (b) the details of works done in the State of Bihar including in district Gopalganj under this mission during each of the last three years;**
- (c) whether any measures are being/have been taken to reduce urban migration by ensuring basic services under SPMRM in Bihar;**
- (d) if so, the details thereof; and**
- (e) whether it is fact that under the Mission, the data regarding reducing urban migration by ensuring basic services under SPMRM are not being maintained and if so, the reasons therefor?**

ANSWER

- (a) Under the Shyama Prasad Mukherji Rurban Mission (SPMRM), funds are not allocated but are released to States based on their progress and requirements. The details of funds released to the State of Bihar and expenditure is given at Annexure 1.**
- (b) 11 clusters have been allocated to the State of Bihar under SPMRM. No cluster was selected in the district of Gopalganj under the mission. The details of work undertaken in the State of Bihar is at Annexure 2.**
- (c) & (d) The objective of SPMRM was to stimulate local economic development, enhance basic services, and create well planned Rurban clusters. Projects pertaining to economic activity have been**

taken under SPMRM in the State of Bihar to promote livelihood at local level and thereby contain distress migration to urban areas. Some of the projects undertaken are cultivation of mushroom farming, poly house, agri processing unit, dairy processing unit, work sheds, marketing sheds, E-auto Rickshaw, construction of godown/cold storage etc. The component wise detail is at Annexure 3.

(e) The data regarding migration is not maintained by the Ministry of Rural Development.
