DDUGKY

754. SHRI SUNIL DATTATRAY TATKARE:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has achieved the objective for which Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDUGKY) was launched and if so, the details thereof;**
- (b) the number of Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Kendras (DDUGKK) operating and the number of training programmes being run in these kendras in various parts of the country including Maharashtra;**
- (c) the number of youth who were imparted training and got employed in these kendras during each the last three years and the current year;**
- (d) whether the Government has achieved the targets of setting up of DDUGKK and also imparting quality training in these kendras and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;**
- (e) whether the Government has utilized the funds allocated for DDUGKK during each of the last five years and if so, the details thereof; and**
- (f) the minimum placement rate given in the DDUGKY along with the actual placement rate during each of the last five years, State/UT-wise?**

ANSWER

- (a) Yes, Sir. Deen Dayal Upadhyay-Grameen Kaushal Yojana (DDUGKY) is an ongoing scheme and is achieving its objective of making rural poor youth employable by imparting skill training and large number of the youths skilled under this program are getting**

employed in jobs having regular monthly wages equal to or above the minimum wages notified by the State.

(b) State-wise number of training centres being operated by PIAs in the country are given at Annexure-I. Data of the number of training programs being run in these training centres is not maintained by the Ministry.

(c) The State-wise details of the candidates trained and placed during each of the last three years and the current year are given at Annexure-II.

(d) The Government does not set up Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Kendras. Under Deen Dayal Upadhyaya Grameen Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY), Training centers are set up by Project Implementing Agencies (PIA) for training under courses approved by National Skills Qualification Council.

(e) The details of total funds allocated for DDU-GKY scheme and the total funds released to all States/ UTs under the scheme during each of the last five years and current year are given below:
