(a) whether the progress of Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) projects in Kerala is as per schedule to achieve the target in 2024 and if so, the details thereof; and

(b) whether fund allotted by the Government is adequate to achieve the target by 2024 and if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b) As reported by the state of Kerala, as on 17.07.2023, 35.21 lakh (49.73%) households out of 70.81 lakh rural households, are having tap water connections in the State. The State has been advised to further expedite the pace of implementation and achieve 100% coverage within the mission period of JJM.
