- (a) the details of performance of Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana– National Rural Livelihood Mission (DAY-NRLM) since its inception;
- (b) the total funds utilized by the States under DAY-NRLM since its inception, State-wise; and
- (c) the steps taken by the Government in uplifting women in this regard?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

(a) The Ministry is implementing Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana – National Rural Livelihoods Mission (DAY – NRLM) across the country (except Delhi & Chandigarh) with the objective of organizing the rural poor women into Self Help Groups (SHGs) and continuously nurturing and supporting them till they attain appreciable increase in incomes over a period of time and improve their quality of life and come out of abject poverty. The performance of DAY-NRLM on major Performance Indicators since inception are as below:
