PMAY-G IN JHARKHAND

813. SHRI VISHNU DAYAL RAM:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the amount of funds allocated, sanctioned and utilized under Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana–Gramin (PMAY-G) during the last three years and the current year, State-wise including Jharkhand;**
- (b) the details of targets set and achievements made under the said yojana, State-wise;**
- (c) the details and the number of houses provided so far to the poor as well as the people living below poverty line under this yojana;**
- (d) whether the progress of works/projects under the yojana has been slow in some States and if so, the details thereof along with the reasons therefor and the remedial steps taken in this regard; and**
- (e) the other steps taken/being taken by the Government to increase the coverage under the said yojana?**

ANSWER

- (a) The details of Central Share released & funds utilized (including State Share) under Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana- Gramin (PMAY-G) during the last three years 2020-21 to 2022-23 and current Financial Year 2023-24 (up to 19.07.2023), and State-wise including the State of Jharkhand is given in Annexure-I.**
- (b) The State-wise targets set and achievements under Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana- Gramin (PMAY-G) since inception is given in Annexure-II.**
- (c) The PMAY-G is being implemented with effect from 1st April 2016 to provide assistance to eligible rural households on the basis of the Socio-Economic Caste Census (SECC), 2011 and the Awaas+**

2018 survey. The eligible households under PMAY-G are selected using housing deprivation, automatic inclusion and exclusion parameters. Under PMAY-G, out of a total target of 2.95 crore, a total of 2,92,37,485 houses have been sanctioned to beneficiaries and 2,40,87,848 houses have been completed under PMAY-G across the country, as of 19.07.2023. However, year-wise and State-wise details of the total funds released under Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana - Gramin (PMAY-G) during the last three years i.e. financial years (FY) 2020-21 to 2022-23 is given under Annexure-I.

(d) to (e): During the period of the Covid-19 pandemic-induced nationwide lockdown, all construction activities including the construction of houses under PMAY-G got also affected. Besides, the delays are also due to delays in the release of Central & State Shares from the State Treasury to the State Nodal Account of PMAY-G, cases of unwillingness of beneficiaries, permanent migration, disputed succession of deceased beneficiaries, local factors, delay in allotment of land to landless beneficiaries by the States/UTs and at times General/Assembly/Panchayat elections, unavailability of building materials. The Ministry is taking the following initiatives to ensure timely completion of the houses under PMAY-G:

- i. Regular review of progress at the level of Ministry.**
- ii. Launch of PMAY-G analytic Dashboard for monitoring and supervision of the scheme.**
- iii. Timely allocation of targets to the States/UTs and release of adequate funds.**
- iv. Regular follow ups with the State to ensure release of central and state share of funds and provision of land to landless beneficiaries in rural areas.**
- v. Awards to the best performing States/UTs, Districts based on performance index dashboard, thereby creating healthy competition and motivation among the States/UTs for achieving the set targets.**
