VOCAL FOR LOCAL IN FOOD PROCESSING SECTOR

829. SHRI MANOJ KOTAK:

Will the MINISTER OF FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has taken any initiative for Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyaan- Vocal for Local in Food Processing Sector;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise especially in Maharashtra;
- (c) whether the Government is helping the micro enterprises in the challenges faced by them;
- (d) if so, the details thereof;
- (e) whether the Government has any proposal for Capacity Building and entrepreneurship development for micro enterprises working in the field of Food Processing Industries; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

- (a) & (b): As part of Aatma Nirbhar Bharat Abhiyan, the Ministry of Food Processing industries (MoFPI) is implementing a centrally sponsored "Pradhan Mantri Formalisation of Micro Food Processing Enterprises (PMFME) Scheme" for extending credit linked subsidy to the interested individual/entity for upgradation of existing or setting up of new micro-food processing facility, in accordance with the scheme guidelines.39,915 loans have been sanctioned to beneficiaries located in various States/ UTs, including 8049 in Maharashtra, under the scheme till 15th July 2023.
- (c) & (d): Handholding support is provided to the beneficiary for project formulation, execution, access to credit, linkages to machine/equipment manufacturers, maintenance of hygiene & quality control etc. through different components of the PMFME scheme such as promotional activities, capacity building, and marketing & branding.
- (e)& (f): Training on "entrepreneurship development" and "food processing" is given to the beneficiary of credit linked subsidy and seed capital, under the Capacity Building component of the scheme.

A total of 492 Master Trainers; 1014 District Level Trainers; 1739 District Resource Persons; and 43157 beneficiaries of PMFME scheme have been given training on Food Processing and Entrepreneurship Development in different States/UTs, so far.
