877. SHRI RAJIV RANJAN SINGH ALIAS LALAN SINGH:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the funds allocated and released under Indira Awas Yojana (IAY) renamed as Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Gramin (PMAY-G) in Bihar during each of the last five years;**
- (b) whether the Government is discriminating in the said yojana and if so, the details thereof; and**
- (c) the details of funds released to Bihar under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) during the said period?**

(a) Under Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana- Gramin (PMAY-G), a total of Rs. 26,615.65 Crore has been released as Central share and state has incurred expenditure of Rs. 41,545.80 crore (including State share) during the last 5 years. The year-wise details are as under:

(b) No, Sir. The targets under PMAY-G are set annually on the basis of availability of eligible beneficiaries, achievements of targets allocated during the preceding years and proposal of the State/UT. After allocation of annual targets, further distribution of targets among the beneficiaries in various districts/blocks/villages is done by the States/UTs on the basis of eligible number of beneficiaries in the Permanent Wait List (PWL). The Ministry has

already allocated full and final target of 37,03,355 houses to the state of Bihar, including 10,03,148 from the finalized Awaas+ list. Out of this, 37,03,024 houses have been sanctioned to the beneficiaries by the state and 36,12,664 houses have been completed.

(c) The Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (Mahatma Gandhi NREGS) is a demand driven wage employment Scheme which provides for the enhancement of livelihood security of the households in rural areas of the country by providing at least one hundred days of guaranteed wage employment in every financial year to every household whose adult members volunteer to do unskilled manual work.

The details of funds released to the State of Bihar under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS in the last five financial years are given below:
