(a) to (d): Sir, Government of India provides a lot of support for promotion of Industrial activities across the country. However, setting up of industries is primarily under the prerogative of the State Governments. Government of India, through the Department for Promotion of Industry & Internal Trade and other Central Ministries/Departments, provides an enabling eco-system for the overall industrial development of the country, including Telangana through appropriate policy interventions. No centralized information on assistance provided to State governments, with respect to industries, is maintained.

Government of India also supplements the efforts of the State/UT Governments through various schemes, programmes and policy initiatives for promotion and development of MSMEs across the country. These schemes and programmes inter alia include Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), Credit Guarantee Scheme for Micro and Small Enterprises, Micro and Small Enterprises Cluster Development Programme (MSE-CDP), etc. Benefits under these schemes are available to all eligible MSMEs throughout the country.
