Compensation to Displaced Families by CIL

954. SHRI VISHNU DAYAL RAM:

Will the Minister of COAL be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the compensation and rehabilitation has been raised by the displaced families, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the State-wise details of total funds spent by Coal India Ltd. and its subsidiaries as the compensation to displaced families during the last three years;
- (c) whether the Government has assessed the loss suffered by coal mines due to the protest of such displaced families and if so, the details thereof; and
- (d) the number of criminal cases registered against such protestors during the last three years?

- (a): No compensation and rehabilitation have been 'raised'.
- (b): State-wise details of total funds spent by subsidiaries of CIL in last three years as compensation to displaced families are as under:-

(c): No, such loss suffered due to protest of such displaced families has been done by the Government of India level. However loss assessment done at the few subsidiaries level are as under:-

Central Coalfields Limited (CCL):

Information regarding one such case is available which occurred in Argada Area. Assessment in respect of bandh called by Gidi A tenants was done. Due to the agitation by the villagers the Mine was not in operation for Nine (9) days and the assessed loss was Rs 50730000/-

South Eastern Coalfields Limited (SECL):

The details of loss suffered by coal mines of SECL due to the protest of such displaced families during Financial Year 2022-23 are as under:-
