#### **Syngas Production**

### 978. SHRI ABDUL KHALEQUE: SHRI SHYAM SINGH YADAV:

Will the Minister of Coal be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has information on the total volume of Syngas production through the coal-gasification process;
- (b) if so, the details of targets achieved during last year in terms of production of Syngas and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Government has any policy framework to incentivize private sector companies for upscaling coal-gasification projects; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

#### **ANSWER**

# MINISTER OF PARLIAMENTARY AFFAIRS, COAL AND MINES (SHRI PRALHAD JOSHI)

- (a) & (b): As per information available, at present, there is only one private sector coal gasification plant is in operation at Angul of capacity 2,25,000 NM3/h for producing Direct Reduced Iron (DRI). During the last year, the production of Syngas was varying between 75,000 NM3/hr to 100,000 NM3/hr. There was no target set for production of Syngas.
- (c) & (d): To incentivize private sector companies for upscaling coal-gasification projects, Ministry of Coal has formulated a policy wherein, a provision has been made for 50% rebate in revenue share for all future commercial coal block auctions for the coal used in gasification purpose provided the coal quantity used for gasification is at least 10% of total coal production. Further, separate auction window under Non Regulated Sectgor sector has been created for making coal available for new coal gasification plants.

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
