STOPPING RICE SUPPLY UNDER OMS IN TAMIL NADU

Will the Minister of CONSUMER AFFAIRS, FOOD AND PUBLIC DISTRIBUTION उपभोक्ता मामले, खाद्य और सार्वजनिक वितरण मंत्री be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the Food Corporation of India (FCI) has stopped sale of rice at the rate of Rs. 34/- per kg to the State of Tamil Nadu w.e.f. June, 2023 onwards under the Open Market Scheme (OMS);

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) the reasons for such steps taken by FCI; and

(d) the total number of States that are purchasing rice from FCI under the Open Market Scheme as on date?

(a) to (d): Considering expected deficiency in rainfall caused by El-Nino as speculated by India Meteorological Department due to which Kharif crop production in country may be adversely affected, and in order to control inflationary trends and to maintain adequate stock levels under central pool for distribution under National Food Security Act (NFSA) and other walfare schemes (OWS) for the benefit of the entire population of the country, the sale of wheat and rice under Open Market Sale Scheme (Domestic) [OMSS (D)] for State Governments including Tamil Nadu has been discontinued with effect from 13.06.2023.
