## DIGITAL VILLAGE PILOT PROJECT

## 996. SHRI JANARDAN SINGH SIGRIWAL:

Will the MINISTER OF ELECTRONICS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has launched Digital Village Pilot Project in the country;

(b) if so, the details and salient features thereof indicating the facilities being provided therein;

(c) the present status of Digital Village Pilot Project as on date;

(d) the details of villages/panchayats proposed to be made digital under the said project in the country, State/UT-wise; and

(e) the other efforts being made by the Government to cover all villages of the country under the said project?

#### ANSWER

### MINISTER OF STATE FOR ELECTRONICS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI RAJEEV CHANDRASEKHAR)

(a) to (c): Yes sir, Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY) approved Digital Village Pilot Project on 31.10.2018 to provide education, health, skill development, and financial inclusion services along with government-to-citizen, business-to-citizen in 700 villages [one village from each district of all States and Union Territories (UTs)] across the country, on a pilot basis.

The features and facilities being provided under the said project are as under:

(i) Education service: Courses offered under this are Basic Computer Course (BCC), Course on Computer Concept (CCC), Basic Course in Information Technology (BCIT), and Tally — Kaushal Praman Patra.

(ii) Health services: This covers tele-health and tele-veterinary consultations.

(iii) Financial inclusion: This covers an awareness programme for financial inclusion.

(iv) Solar-panel-powered streetlights: This covers eight solar lights per village.

(v) Skill development: This covers skilling for automotive technician, handset repairing, field technician — home appliances, and electrical technician.
