(a) to (c) Under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA), financial support for various higher education projects is provided to States/UTs including Jharkhand. The district-wise details of projects approved in Jharkhand are **Annexed**. As against the approved total central share of Rs. 380.6 crores, since inception of the scheme an amount of Rs. 259.28 crores has been released out of which an amount of Rs. 103.86 crores has been released to the State since 2019-20 (last four years and current year, till date). As on 06.12.2023, the State has an unspent balance of Rs. 40.88 crores in its Single Nodal Agency Account. Further releases shall be subject to utilisation of unspent balance and compliance to the scheme guidelines.

In addition, Central government provides fund for other Centrally funded Higher Education Institutions under the Department of Higher Education in the State of Jharkhand and funds released during the last four years and the current year for such institutions are as below:
