Centre for Tribal Studies provides Post Graduate Diploma and Ph.D. Programme in Central University of Himachal Pradesh. The area for PG Diploma programme broadly includes – custom, tradition, culture of Indian tribal communities, tribal policies and legislations, endangered tribal communities and their languages, historical perspective of tribal policies, tribal communities of Himachal Pradesh etc.

Research work undertaken by the in PhD Scholars in the University:

- Study of social and cultural heritage of Ghirth caste (a study in the context of Kangra district)
- Folklore of Tangsa Tribe in Arunachal Pradesh: A socio-cultural study
- The Concept of Tribe in Colonial India: A Study
- Hygiene Management among Adolescent Girls of Gaddi Tribe in Bharmour (H.P)
- Social and cultural study of Gaddi tribe (with special reference to Himachal Pradesh)
- Studying the reach and impact of New Media on the Tribal communities in Himachal Pradesh
- An exploratory study of the Lavanya community of Kashmir.
- Gujjar Community: Gotra System and Communication Traditions
