STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO THE LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 175 DUE FOR ANSWER ON 14.12.2023 REGARDING DEVELOPMENT OF AMARAVATI CITY UNDER HRIDAY.

(a) to (d): The Heritage City Development and Augmentation Yojana (HRIDAY) was launched on 21st January 2015. The details of works undertaken and completed in Amaravati City (Andhra Pradesh) during the mission period is at Annexure. The mission period of the HRIDAY ended on 31st March, 2019 and no new cities were taken up after 31st March, 2019 by the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs. On discontinuation of the HRIDAY scheme, the heritage component of the scheme has been included in National Mission on Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual, Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD) which is administered by the Ministry of Tourism.
