LANNING OF G.T. ROAD'**

(a) and (b) Yes Sir, The stretch from Aligarh to Kanpur with a length of about 284 km has been awarded for 4-laning. Out of 284 km, 277 km has been 4-laned and the schedule revised completion period for balance length is February, 2024. The section from Aligarh to Ghaziabad is already 4-laned. Further, 6-laning of the section has been awarded and 94 km length has been completed. The schedule revised completion period of balance length of 12 km is April, 2024. The section from Delhi to Ghaziabad has been developed to 14-lane as part of Delhi-Meerut Expressway.

(c) The maintenance of the road is under the scope of respective Contractor/Concessionaire.
