*80. SHRI DEEPAK BAIJ:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) the present status of the construction of Raipur to Dhamtari, Jagdalpur four-lane National Highway (NH) Number-30;
- (b) the target set for completion of the said Highway and the portion of the work completed so far;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to construct a bypass on Keshkal ghati, Bastar connecting the said Highway and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) the views of the Ministry on construction of four lane road on NH from Jagdalpur to Nagarnar and bypass construction in order to control the increasing traffic pressure on the Jagdalpur road route of Chhattisgarh;
- (e) the details of the action taken on the proposal received from the people's representatives in this regard;
- (f) the details of the National Highways constructed by the Government during the last five years in the country, State and year-wise; and
- (g) the details of funds spent on the construction of the National Highways in Chhattisgarh during the last five years, year-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (g) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 80 ANSWERED ON 07TH DECEMBER, 2023 ASKED BY SHRI DEEPAK BAIJ REGARDING 'FOUR LANING OF NH'

- (a) & (b) The stretch from Raipur to Dhamtari is under construction for 4-laning. Further, Dhamtari to Jagdalpur in under construction for 2 lane and paved shoulder configuration. The status of various projects is as under:-
 - (i) The 4-laning of Raipur to Dhamtari has been awarded for construction in two packages i.e. Raipur-Kodebod & Kodebod-Dhamtari. Presently Raipur-Kodebod project has been provisionally completed (PCC issued w.e.f. 20.06.2023). The revised scheduled date of completion for Kodebod-Dhamtari project (Physical progress-98.44%) is 31.12.2023.
 - (ii) The project Dhamtari-Jagdalpur has been awarded for construction with 2-lane and paved shoulder in 04 packages. Out of four packages, work is completed in 03 packages (i.e. Package-01, 03 & 04), the project is under 0&M & tolling through NHAI since March 2019. The revised scheduled date of completion date for package-2 (Physical progress-46.70%) is 31.12.2024.
- (c) The work of Kanker-Bedma Section has been awarded which also includes construction of Keshkal bypass of 11.38 Km length.
- (d) & (e) Ministry has included the work of preparation of Detailed Project Report(DPR)/ Project Management Consultancy(PMC) for Jagdalpur to Dhanpanji(Chattisgarh/Orissa border) including the bypass to Jagdalpur in Annual Plan 2023-24. After the completion of DPR, further action can be taken based on outcome of DPR, traffic density, inter-se-priority, availability of fund etc.
- (f) Details of NH constructed, State wise during the last five years is Annexed.
- (g) The total funds spent on development, maintenance and management of the National Highways section the state of Chhattisgarh during the last five years is as under:-
