Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the date since 'Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao' (BBBP) scheme is operational in Jharkhand;
- (b) the funds provided by the Union Government to Jharkhand under the said scheme since the launch of the scheme, year-wise;
- (c) the amount utilized and that remained unutilized out of the said funds, in the said State, district-wise and year-wise; and
- (d) the details of the funds utilized out of the amount received for the said scheme in Bokaro, Dhanbad and Giridih districts under Giridih Parliamentary Constituency?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT

(a) Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP) Scheme was launched on 22 January, 2015 with the aim to address declining Child Sex Ratio (CSR) and related issues of empowerment of girls and women over a life cycle continuum.

The scheme was started in selected 100 districts which included 1 district i.e. Dhanbad from Jharkhand. Later, from Financial Year (FY.) 2018-19, 11 more districts namely, Hazaribagh, Giridih, Bokaro, Kodarma, Ramgarh, Ranchi, Purbi Singhbhum, Palamu, Saraikela-Kharsawan, Deoghar and Jamtara were selected for multisectoral interventions.

Further in FY. 2022-23, BBBP has been expanded to cover all the districts of country.

(b) to (d) The funds were released directly to the dedicated account of the districts for implementation of the scheme.

However, from F.Y. 2022-23, funds are being released through State Government State Nodal Agency (SNA) Account for district level multi sectoral interventions. The amount released to State of Jharkhand for implementation of BBBP during F.Y. 2022-23 is Rs. 2.90 crores.

District wise, including Bokaro, Dhanbad and Giridih, details of funds released and utilized under BBBP since inception of the scheme i.e from 2014-15 to 2022-23 is at **Annexure.**
