Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the amount of budget allocation made to the States under the POSHAN Abhiyaan, State/UT-wise;
- (b) the present status of the POSHAN Abhiyaan in Madhya Pradesh, district wise;
- (c) whether the Government has put in place any monitoring mechanism for the smooth operation of the scheme; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) The details of funds, released to States/UTs for Poshan Abhiyan under Saksham Anganwadi and Mission Poshan 2.0 is at **Annexure I.**
- (b) All the districts in Madhya Pradesh are covered under the POSHAN Abhiyaan. The district-wise status of POSHAN Abhiyaan (comprising of number of beneficiaries registered on Poshan Tracker and number of activities conducted during Poshan Maah 2023) in Madhya Pradesh is at **Annexure II & III** respectively.

IT systems have been leveraged to strengthen and bring about transparency in nutrition delivery support systems at the Anganwadi centres. The 'Poshan Tracker' application was rolled out on 1st March, 2021 as an important governance tool. The Poshan Tracker facilitates monitoring and tracking of all AWCs, AWWs and beneficiaries on defined indicators. Technology under Poshan Tracker is being leveraged for dynamic identification of stunting, wasting, under-weight prevalence among children. Further, under Poshan 2.0, for the first time, a digital revolution was ushered in when the Anganwadi Centres were equipped with mobile devices. The mobile application has also facilitated digitization and automation of physical registers used by AWWs that helps in improving their quality of work. Poshan Tracker is available in 22 languages including Hindi and English. It has facilitated near real time data collection for Anganwadi Services such as, daily attendance, ECCE, Provision of Hot Cooked Meal (HCM)/Take Home Ration (THR-not raw ration), Growth Measurement etc. The App also offers counselling videos on key behaviours and services which help disseminate messages on birth preparedness, delivery, post-natal care, breastfeeding and complementary feeding. Steps have been taken to improve nutritional quality and testing in accredited labs, strengthen delivery and leverage technology under Poshan Tracker to improve governance with regard to real time monitoring of provisioning of supplementary nutrition for prompt supervision and management of services.
