WILL THE MINISTER OF HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE BE PLEASED TO STATE:

- a) the details of the budget allocated/utilized for Health & Family Welfare during the last five years, State/UT-wise;
- b) the number of new medical colleges sanctioned during the last five years, State/UT-wise along with the number of MBBS/medical PG seats sanctioned to each new medical college; and
- c) the details of the funds released for construction and establishment of sanctioned new medical colleges, college-wise and State/UT-wise?

ANSWER

**THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE
(DR. Bharati Pravin Pawar)**

(a) The Department of Health and Family Welfare through various Centrally Sponsored Schemes supplements the efforts of the States/UTs in the healthcare sector. The details of budgetary outlays and expenditure during the last five years are enclosed at **Annexure-1**. The State/UT-wise expenditure of flagship Centrally Sponsored Schemes is at **Annexure-2(a), (b) & (c)**.

(b) & (c) The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare administers a Centrally Sponsored Scheme (CSS) for 'Establishment of new medical colleges attached with existing district/referral hospitals' with preference to underserved areas and aspirational districts, where there is no existing Government or private medical college with fund sharing between the Centre and State Governments in the ratio of 90:10 for North Eastern and Special Category States and 60:40 for others. Under the Scheme, 157 Government medical colleges have been approved in three phases, out of these, 101 medical colleges (2, 24 and 75 medical colleges in Phase - I, II and III respectively) have been approved in the last five years. Out of these 101 medical colleges, 55 have become functional and thereby 5500 new undergraduate seats are created. A list of functional medical colleges and numbers of MBBS/medical PG seats is attached at **Annexure- 3 (a)**. The phase wise details of medical colleges approved and funds sanctioned for their construction are at **Annexure-3 (b)**.

Pradhan Mantri Ayushman Bharat Health Infrastructure Mission [PM-ABHIM]

Union Cabinet on 22.04.2020 approved PM-ABHIM with an outlays of Rs 63544.56 Crore for 5 years from 2021-22 to 2025-26 for strengthening public health infrastructure for pandemic preparedness, by setting up infectious disease hospital blocks in all districts, to develop comprehensive diagnostic and treatment capacities, and to develop capacities to provide critical care services, including dialysis, including setting up mentor institutions in Central Hospitals.
